Egyptian records dating from 2500 BCE refer to the use of grapes for wine making, and numerous biblical references to wine indicate the early origin and significance of the industry in the Middle East. The Greeks carried on an active wine trade and planted grapes in their colonies from the Black Sea to Spain. The Romans carried grape growing into the valleys of the Rhine and Moselle (which became the great wineregions of Germany and Alsace), the Danube (of Romania, Serbia, Croatia, Hungary, and Austria), and the Rhöne, Saöne, Garonne, Loire, and Marne (which define the great French regions of Rhöne, Burgundy,Bordeaux, Loire, and Champagne, respectively). The role of wine in the Christian mass helped maintain theindustry after the fall of the Roman Empire, and monastic orders preserved and developed many of thehighly regarded wine-producing areas in Europe.
